Field of Action 1:

Improve the institutional framework and procedures to secure tenure rights in North-eastern Uganda



Outcome indicator:

For <u>5,000 households</u> in North-eastern Uganda, <u>documented</u> and by the State and traditional authorities recognized, <u>land</u> <u>use and land ownership</u> rights are prepared.

Partners: Sub County, ALC



Activities:

- Capacity Building of partners (ALC, DLO, CSO, etc.) to improve framework and procedures to secure land

 Training and mentoring
- Documentation of customary customary rights
 - Study **best practices** (PPRR, ZOA, FAO, etc.)
 - Fusion of traditional demarcation and boundary tree planting with the modern use of technology
 - Approach is *Pro-Poor* and *Fit For Purpose*

Systematic land rights documentation

→ FPIC: Households *decide* if they want to apply for CCO! (Land Inventory, CCO)







Field of Action 2:

Increase the engagement of the civil society in the formalization and implementation of a responsible land policy

Eastern Choice Drama actors during awareness raising.



Outcome indicator:

80% of the land conflicts, that occur during the new processes to secure land use or land ownership rights in the target communities in North-eastern Uganda, will be processed and solved with the participation of civil society actors.



Field Teams

Usually 5 members:

- ✓ Area Land Committee (ALC) member
- ✓ Elder
- ✓ Clan Leader
- ✓ Field Assistant
- ✓ Local Council II (Parish) Chairperson

Plus

✓ Local Council I (Village) Chairperson









Participation

According to legislation:

- Witnesses (representatives from the relevant clan)
- Neighbours
- Family members
- ✓ Community members hold the GPS at the corner point
- ➤ Social Mapping
- > But also *challenge* to have *everybody present*



Challenges

- Buffer zones unclear (physical planning)
 - ➤ Road reserves
 - **≻** Forests
 - ➤ Wetlands
- No visible plot boundaries
- Fear for loss of role and status by Clan Leaders
- Block mapping
- Strict requirements / regulations: passport pictures, sketch maps
- >Incompatibility of regulations with systematic, technologic approach
